Director's Report & Presentation: Adult & Older Adult SOC: Visions & Goals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Kate Jones talked about Crisis Continuum of Care ▪ Amber House will soon open, ▪ Sally's Place recently opened as a short-term peer respite facility. ▪ Three different mobile teams: 2 Clinician model, Mobile Team – EMT & Clinician, and Community Assessment & Transportation Teams ▪ Transit Vans – Set up to look & feel welcoming – Voluntary ▪ Urgent Meds Service at Eastmont: For level 3 (Moderate to Severe), can use up to 2 times a year with a little flexibility allowed for a few beyond the 2 times. Telepsychiatry used for the meds service ▪ CAT Teams: A pilot program in San Leandro & Hayward ▪ RV to assist those with mental health conditions released from Santa Rita Jail late at night.
