This RFP is offered through BHCS Workforce Development, Education and Training (WET) and Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Round 4 Innovations (INN) Grants. One of the department's goals is to diversify the mental and behavioral health care workforce by helping underrepresented students from underserved communities to pursue careers in this field. As such, this RFP is seeking bids that are innovative and support high school and undergraduate students to careers in behavioral and mental health.

Projects must be implemented in an 18-month period, beginning August, 2017 and ending February, 2019. Grant amounts and number of awards are dependent on proposals received. Only qualifying organizations may apply. Individuals are not eligible to apply.
