2. Children's Director Report	<p><b>1.) <u>The Oakland Police Dept. Closing Out Their Youth Services Bureau</u></b>            The OPD has closed down their Youth Service Bureau and reassigned the officers. This means that beat officers will be at a loss since they will not be aware of all the services available to minors. This may mean an increase of minors who will show up at JH for booking and will have to be released if they do not fit the profile of youth who get detained in JH for serious delinquent acts.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Information only</li> </ul>

MHSA Updates	<p><b>1.) <u>MHSA Children's Services</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The prevalence data is showing that there are gaps in services to Asian, Latino, and Native American children and families, as well as to Transitional Age Youth.</li> <li>A question was raised as to whether the Alameda County Board of Supervisors was going to be lodging any form of protest regarding the allocation that Alameda County received.</li> <li>Supervisor Steele raised the question of whether the BOS has been kept aware of the work around MHSA.</li> </ul> <p>There are 4 workgroups in Children &amp; Youth that will be focusing on strategies for a targeted population and/or overall system enhancement/transformation design.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>0 – 6 Workgroup</li> <li>Juvenile Justice/Probation Youth</li> <li>Family/Parent Involvement</li> <li>Wraparound</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A recommendation was made to reach out to the Board of Supervisors to alert them of upcoming meetings especially the Stakeholders Group.</li> </ul>

This seems to be a larger planning effort than possible under the MHSA planning effort.
