Willow Rock Center – Adolescent Psych Health Facility by Serena Lourie of Telecare and Jill Mason of Seneca	<p>Willow Rock Center This is a partnership of service between Alameda County Behavioral Health Care Service, Seneca and Telecare. The Willow Rock Center (WRC) was created for Alameda County Adolescents experiencing high levels of distress who can benefit from a structured and safe environment.</p> <p>WRC has (3) components: a 23-hour crisis response service; an acute inpatient program; and a short-term outpatient/transition back to the community program. The adolescent crisis response service helps individuals cope with problems that can be resolved in 23 hours or less. The average length of stay for inpatient services is three to seven days.</p> <p>Services include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Youth on 5150 (involuntary 72-hour hold until mental health evaluation of the need for hospitalization has been completed). ▪ Comprehensive evaluation and risk assessment. ▪ Collaborative treatment planning with a resilience focus. ▪ Crisis stabilization and prevention. ▪ Supportive counseling, on a group and individual basis. ▪ Discharge planning, including linkage with community supports and services. ▪ Neuropsychological assessment. <p>Who is Served: Adolescents from ages 12 – 17 years old, who are residents of Alameda County and in need of acute/crisis mental health services.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Information only.
