order to meet new regulations, Quality Assurance has been working with Information Systems to develop new versions of the Assessments in CG. We will launch the new forms on April 1, 2017 along with new versions of the Plan.

- Use the new "Assessment Update" template to update all clients in CG to DSM-5 and ICD-10 codes.
- If possible, we will launch the Assessment Update template ahead of 4/1/2017.

Highlights of the features incorporated into the Assessment Update.

- The Diagnosis section has been moved from the Plans to the Assessments
- DSM-5 and ICD-10 codes are cross-walked in the Diagnosis section
- The Assessment Update template has been created for mid-year updates
- The Primary Dx DSM-5 from the latest Assessment will be displayed on all notes in the "Pre-Existing Diagnosis" display

To Use the Assessment Update:

1. Choose Assessment Update as the Note Template type and click Start

- Start with **Mental Health** section. **ALWAYS ENTER THE PRIMARY DX FIRST, MATCHING THE PRIMARY DX CODE IN INSYST.**

Start to enter a value using either the DSM-5 Descriptor, the ICD-10 Code, or the ICD-10 Descriptor fields. Then, choose the corresponding DSM-5 or ICD-10 value.

Choose the choice by clicking on it

6. The values you enter in the **Mental Health section** almost always correspond to the values entered into InSyst

a. **THE MENTAL HEALTH PRIMARY DX CODE SHOULD ALWAYS MATCH INSYST EXACTLY.**

b. Any additional Mental Health Dx should match Insyst if possible, especially the second and third values. This is so you can easily compare between CG and InSyst. The second and third values in InSyst are displayed in the Pre-existing Diagnoses display on the top of notes and assessments in CG.

c. However, in CG, any codes after the Primary Dx in the Mental Health section can use one of the "excluded" Dx codes. These excluded Dx codes are not accepted in InSyst.

7. Continue to fill in the **Substance Use, Physical Health and Psycho Social** fields in the same manner as above.
- The first value for Substance Use should match InSyst. More values can be entered into CG.
 - The first three General Medical Codes should match InSyst. More values can be entered into CG.
 - The Psycho-Social codes are not captured in InSyst.
