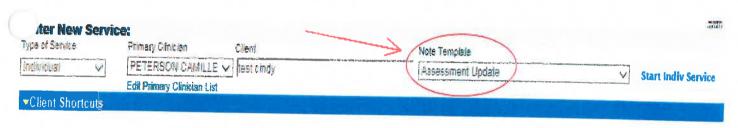
- Use the new "Assessment Update" template to update all clients in CG to DSM-5 and ICD-10 codes.

Highlights of the features incorporated into the Assessment Update.

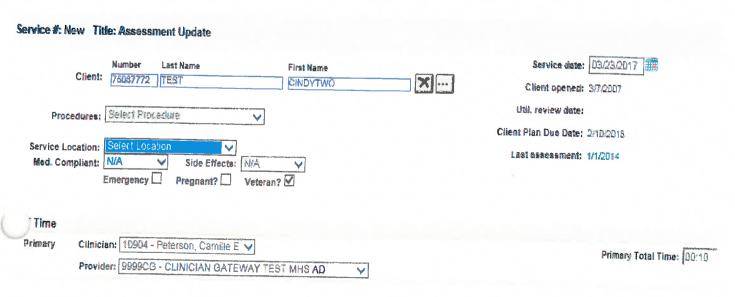
- > The Diagnosis section has been moved from the Plans to the Assessments
- DSM-5 and ICD-10 codes are cross-walked in the Diagnosis section
- > The Assessment <u>Update</u> template has been created for mid-year updates
- ➤ The Primary Dx DSM-5 from the latest Assessment will be displayed on all notes in the "Pre-Existing Diagnosis" display

To Use the Assessment Update:

1. Choose Assessment Update as the Note Template type and click Start



2. On the Assessment Update Form, enter the procedure code, date, duration, etc as usual.



3. View the Pre-Existing Dx information. Note that if InSyst hasn't been updated in the new fields, or if a new CG Assessment template hasn't been used yet, then the pre-existing values will be blank.

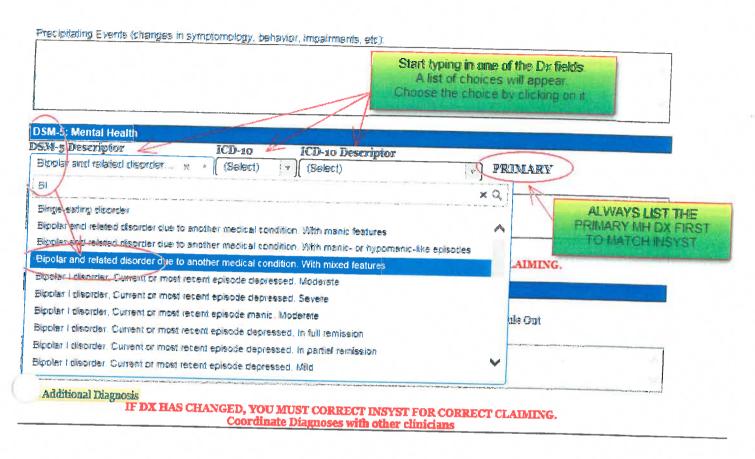

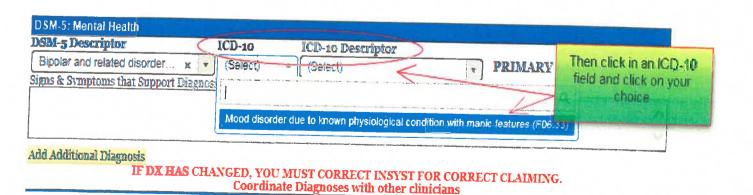

- 6. The values you enter in the Mental Health section almost always correspond to the values entered into InSyst
 - a. THE MENTAL HEALTH PRIMARY DX CODE SHOULD ALWAYS MATCH INSYST **EXACTLY.**
 - b. Any additional Mental Health Dx should match Insyst if possible, especially the second and third values. This is so you can easily compare between CG and InSyst. The second and third values in InSyst are displayed in the Pre-existing Diagnoses display on the top of notes and assessments in CG.
