Director's Report	A. Forensic System Redesign Update A presentation to the BOS Health Committee meeting held on May 10, 2021 was presented to the MHAB by Dr. Tribble, ACBH Director. A few key points were highlighted enumerating the areas that has been completed and implemented since October 2020 including the new positions hired as of January 2020, as well as next steps.	
	Dr. Tribble also acknowledged the efforts made between other partners namely the District Attorney's Office, Probation, Public Defender, Law Enforcement, and Fire Department, which contributed to its success. She also added that the JIMH	

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	taskforce contract will end on June 30, 2021. A preliminary report will be provided in June by the Executive Director of Jewel Legacy, Carol Burton. Dr. Tribble also shared a condensed report identifying a system plan across each intercept of the progress and added that the report will serve as a tool to help guide with organization of areas in terms of short-terms goals, medium term goals and long-term goals. B. Care First, Jails Last Resolution The BOS Health Committee agreed to move the Care First, Jails Last Resolution next week for the Board of Supervisors' review and approval. James Wagner, ACBH Deputy Director of Clinical Operations provided a detailed scenario regarding the intake screening process provided by ACBH staff at Santa Rita. Documents attached.
